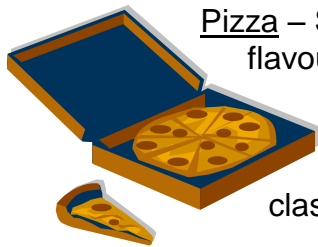
AFTERNOON PICKUP:

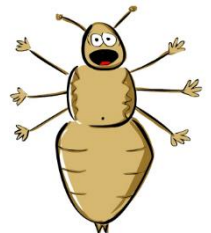
Pizza – Starting in January pizza will be sold on **Thursday's**. Pizza flavours will include Cheese, Hawaiian, and cheese with pepperoni.
